## Battery Replacement Reset Procedures

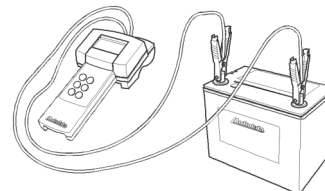
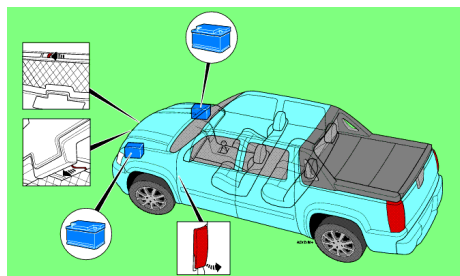
