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REQUIREMENTS - Please read the conditions below before commencing appropriation.

The temporary appropriation may commence 5 days after receipt of this form by the Area Hydrologist, or upon verbal approval of the Area Hydrologist, provided that all conditions of General Permit 1997-0005 are satisfied. If a natural resource conflict is expected, the Area Hydrologist will contact the applicant and advise them that the General Permit cannot be used.

Please note that a \$140 water use fee is required for all projects that exceed **15 million gallons**. If the estimated volume shown above exceeds 15 million gallons, the applicant will receive an Invoice from the State of Minnesota demanding payment of the \$140 water use fee. In all cases, after completion of the project, the enclosed "Report of Water Use" form must be completed and transmitted to the address shown on the form.

Save this completed form onto your computer, then send as an email attachment, or print it and send by fax or mail so that the appropriate Area Hydrologist will receive it at least five days before the start of pumping.
